## BEDFORDSHIRE COLTS KNOCK-OUT CUP COMPETITION RULES

- 1. A club must be a member of the East Midlands Rugby Union and the Bedfordshire County Rugby Union.
- 2. The Competition will be organised by the Bedfordshire County Rugby Union (incorporating Bedfordshire County Colts Rugby Union) General Committee, hereafter referred to as "the Committee".
- 3. All Clubs entering this competition agree to abide by these rules and any decision or ruling made by the Committee, whose decision shall be final.
- 4. Entries must be received at a date decided by the Committee.
- 5. The draw will be made at the AGM by the Committee. Once the first round is drawn, the competition will proceed on a knock-out basis. The draw for ground advantage for each round will be made at the Annual General Meeting.
- 6. Matches must be played on the date specified by the AGM during the Cup draw. The Home drawn Club should make the initial contact.
- 7. The Home Club shall be responsible for all match arrangements including the obtaining a Society Referee who must be shown a copy of these rules.
- 8. The Laws of the Rugby Union should apply.
- 9. If, after 35 minutes of play each way the scores are level the team that has scored most tries shall be declared the winner. If this does not produce a result, the team that has scored most goals from tries shall be declared the winner. If this still does not produce a result, the Visiting team shall be declared the winner.
- 10. The winning Club shall notify the Secretary, as soon as possible, of the result. He will then inform the Club of their next opponent.
- 11. A player may represent ONE Club only in any one season in this competition and must be a member of that club.
- 12. Players taking part in this competition must be under 18 years of age at midnight on 1st September of that season's competition.
- 13. Any dispute should be sent in writing to the Secretary and the matter will be referred to the Committee whose decision will be final.
